

MANDATED AND PERMITTED PUPIL RECORDS

Mandated pupil records are those pupil records, which the schools have been directed to compile by New Jersey Statute, regulation or authorized administrative directive. Examples are: personal identifying data--pupil's name, address, date of birth, name of parents and/or guardians, citizenship and sex of pupil; record of daily attendance; description of pupil progress; history and status of physical health compiled in accordance with State regulations; records regarding educationally handicapped pupils; and all other records required by the State.

Permitted pupil records are those, which a local board of education has authorized the district to collect by resolution adopted at a regular public meeting. Examples are: group achievement and intelligence tests, aptitude tests and interest inventories, systematically gathered faculty ratings and observations, and verified reports of serious or recurrent behavior patterns.
