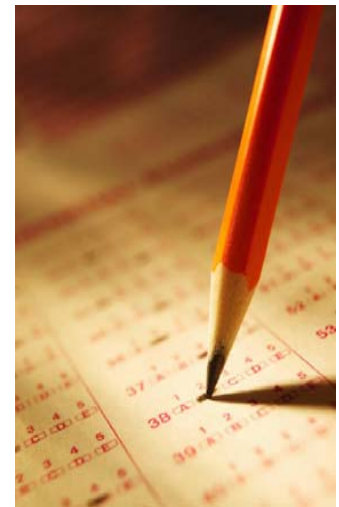

# NJ Statewide Assessments



- As a result of the No Child Left Behind Act, New Jersey's statewide assessment of students changed in 2003.
- Students in grades 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 & 8 take the NJ Assessment of Skills and Knowledge (ASK) and students in grade 11 take the High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA). Students are scored as proficient, advanced proficient or partially proficient.
- These assessments are grounded in the state's core curriculum content standards, and are designed to assess students' critical thinking skills in two fundamental areas: Language Arts Literacy (LAL) and Mathematics. Students at grade 4 and 8 are also assessed in science, but science results are not considered for NCLB reporting.
- In 2009 an end-of-course assessment was operational for Biology for high school students to replace the HSPA science assessment, and in 2010 an end-of-course assessment in Algebra I will be added. At this time, students will still take the HSPA mathematics assessment.
- New assessments were introduced for grades 3 & 4 designed to add additional rigor and better alignment to the standards.

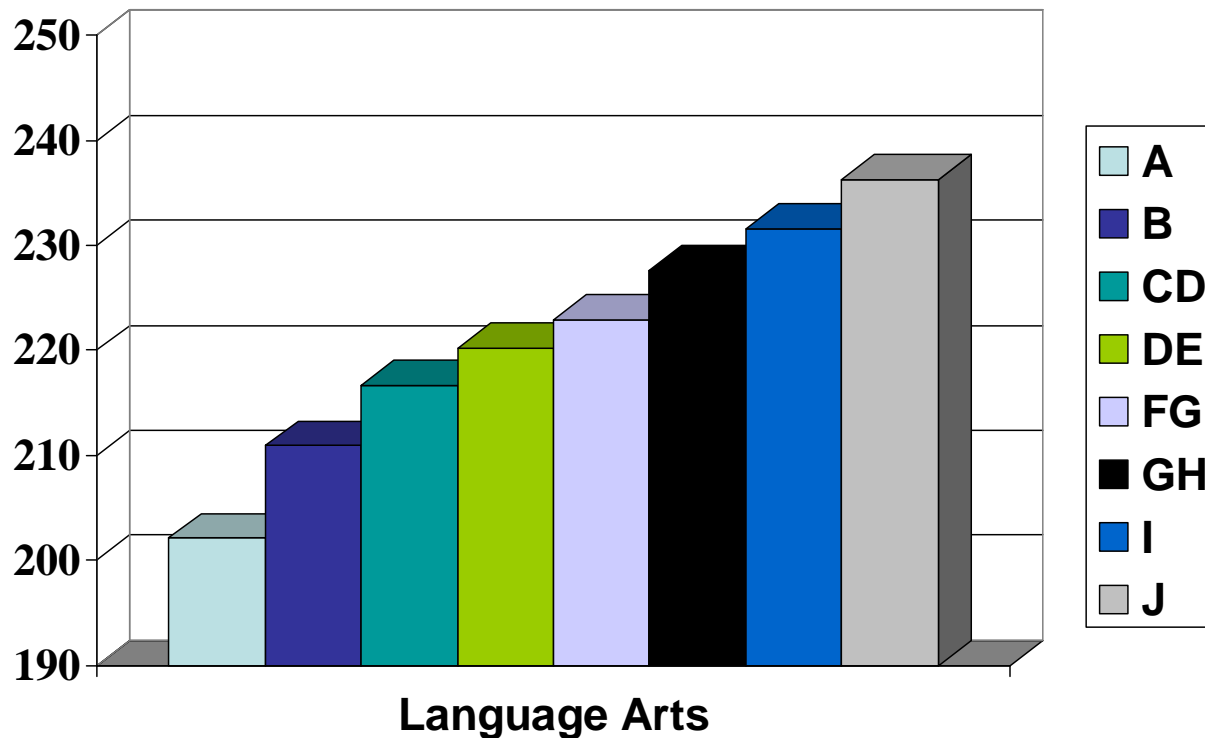

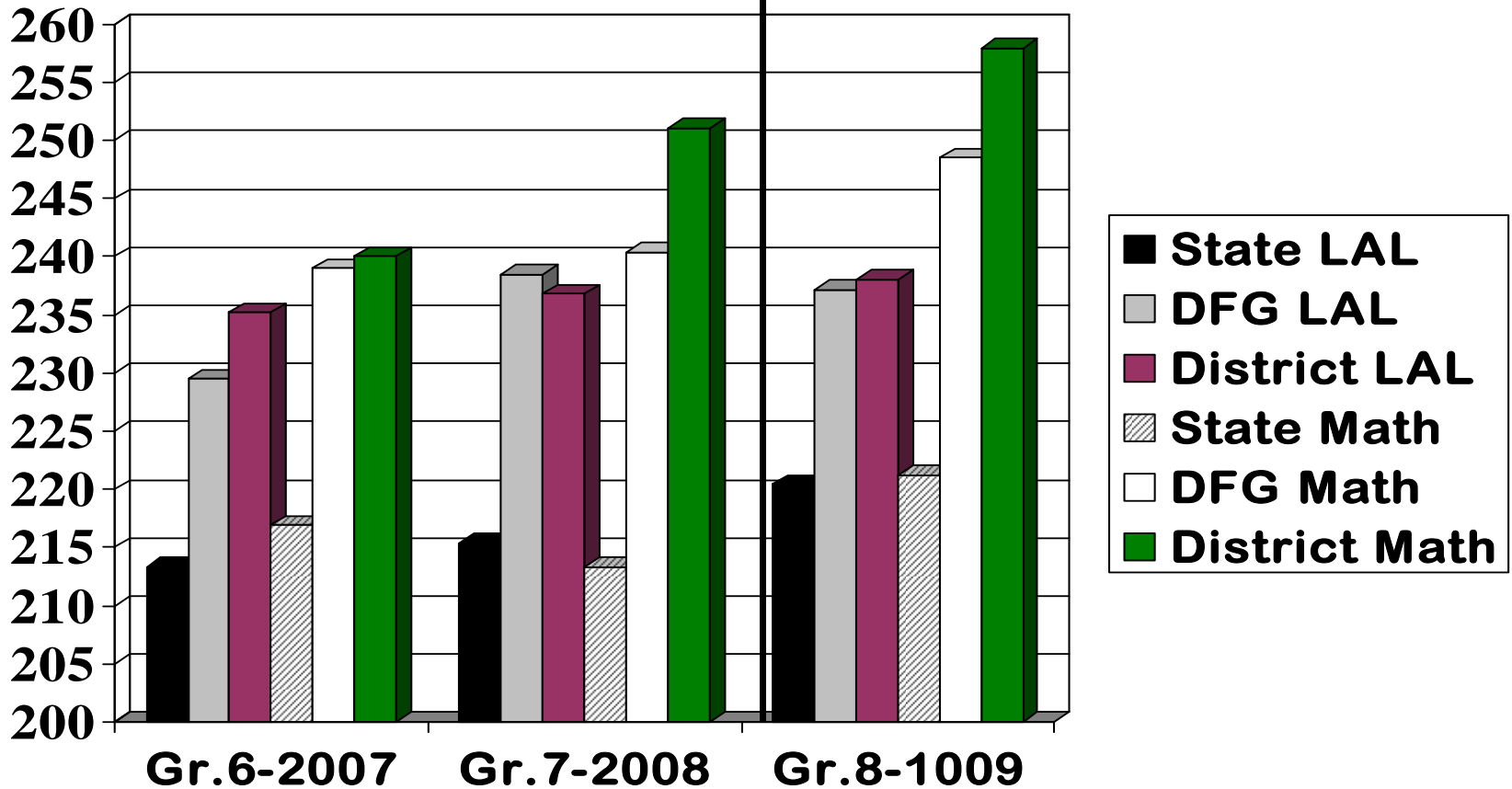
# NJ ASK 2009 Comparative Results



- Comparing Haddonfield's success rate for the cohort of students currently in grade 8 to statewide & DFG total student performance
- Tracking the percentage of grade 8 students scoring advanced proficient from 2004-2009
- The summer 2009 state decision to request to reset AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress) starting points and AMOs (Annual Measurable Objectives) for NJ ASK 3-4 student achievement has delayed the receipt of final results for grades 3, 4 & 5.

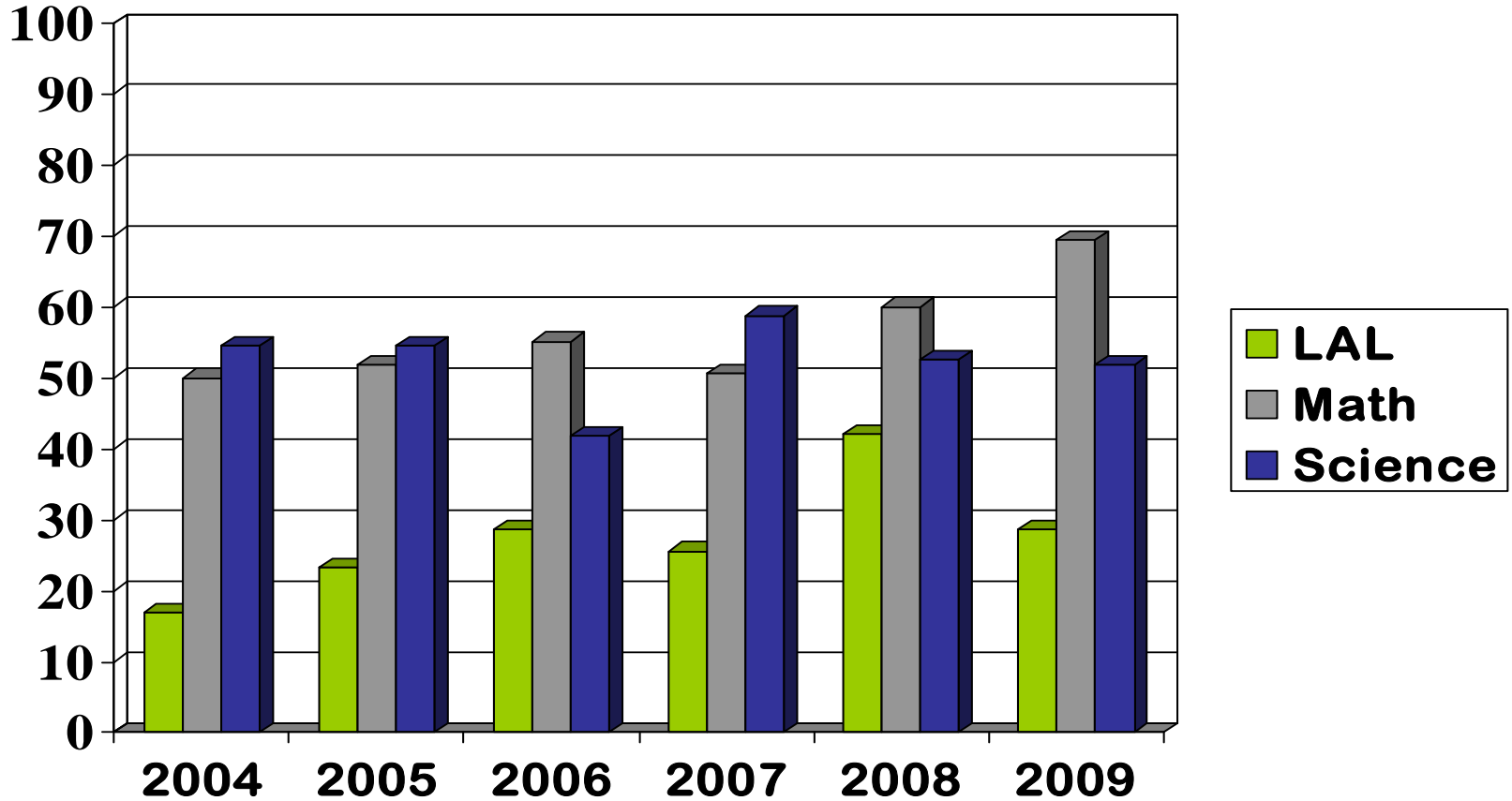
# NJ ASK Gr. 8 Cohort Performance 2007-2009

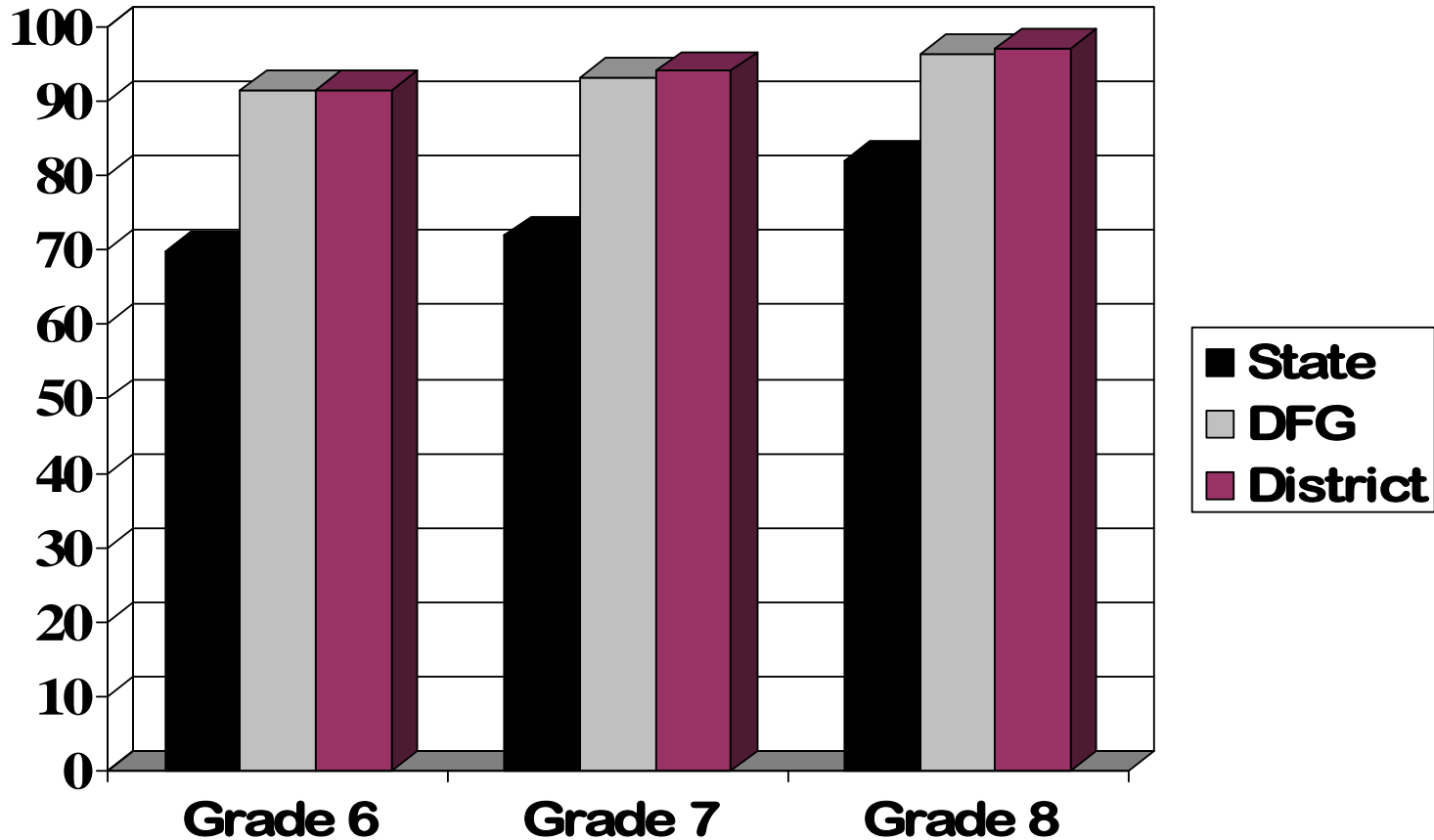


Results by grade levels for state, DFG, and district proficient and advanced proficient (pass rates) for the total group of students assessed with NJ ASK/HSPA Spring 2009



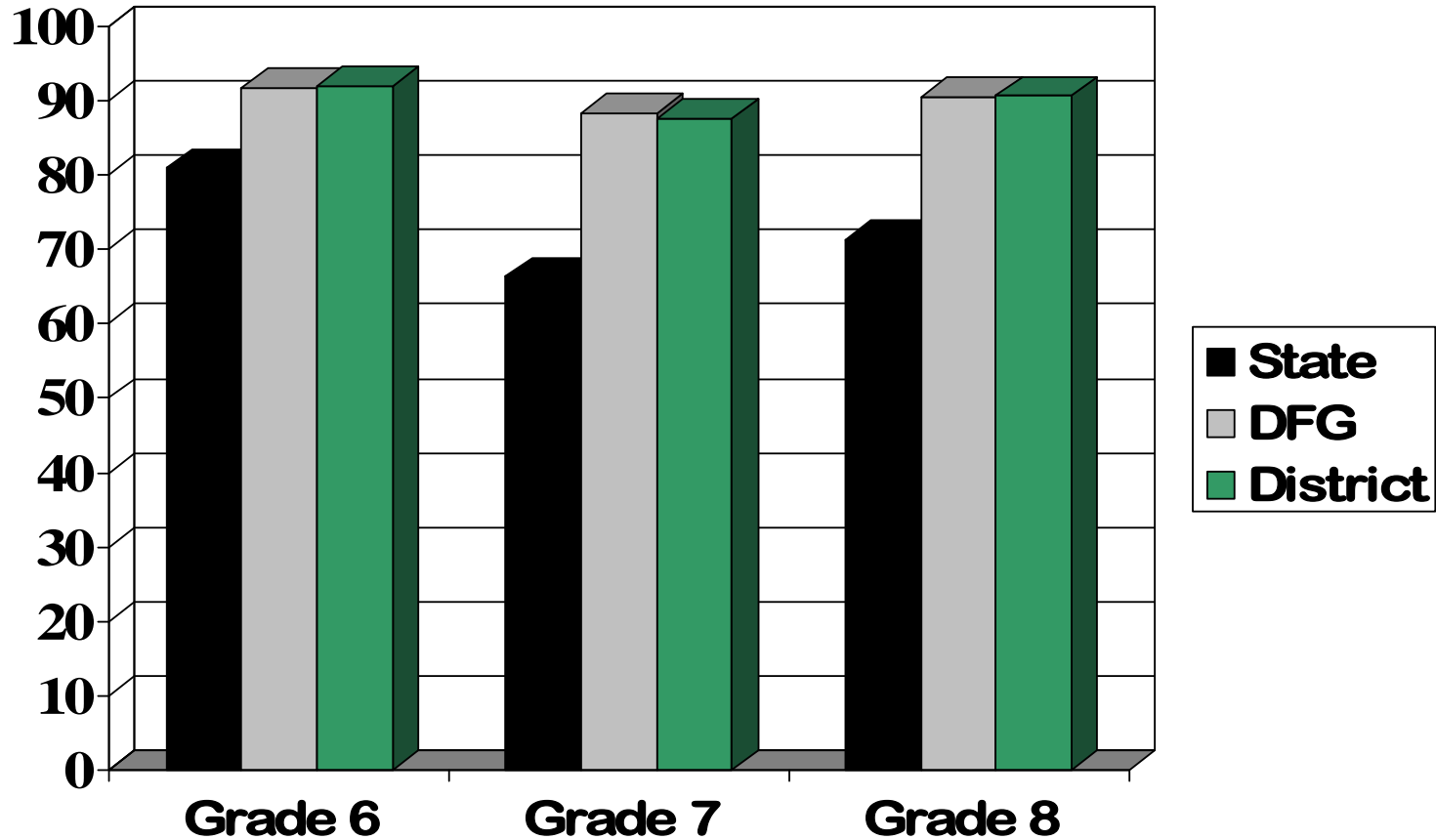

# NJ ASK 6-7-8 Mathematics 2009

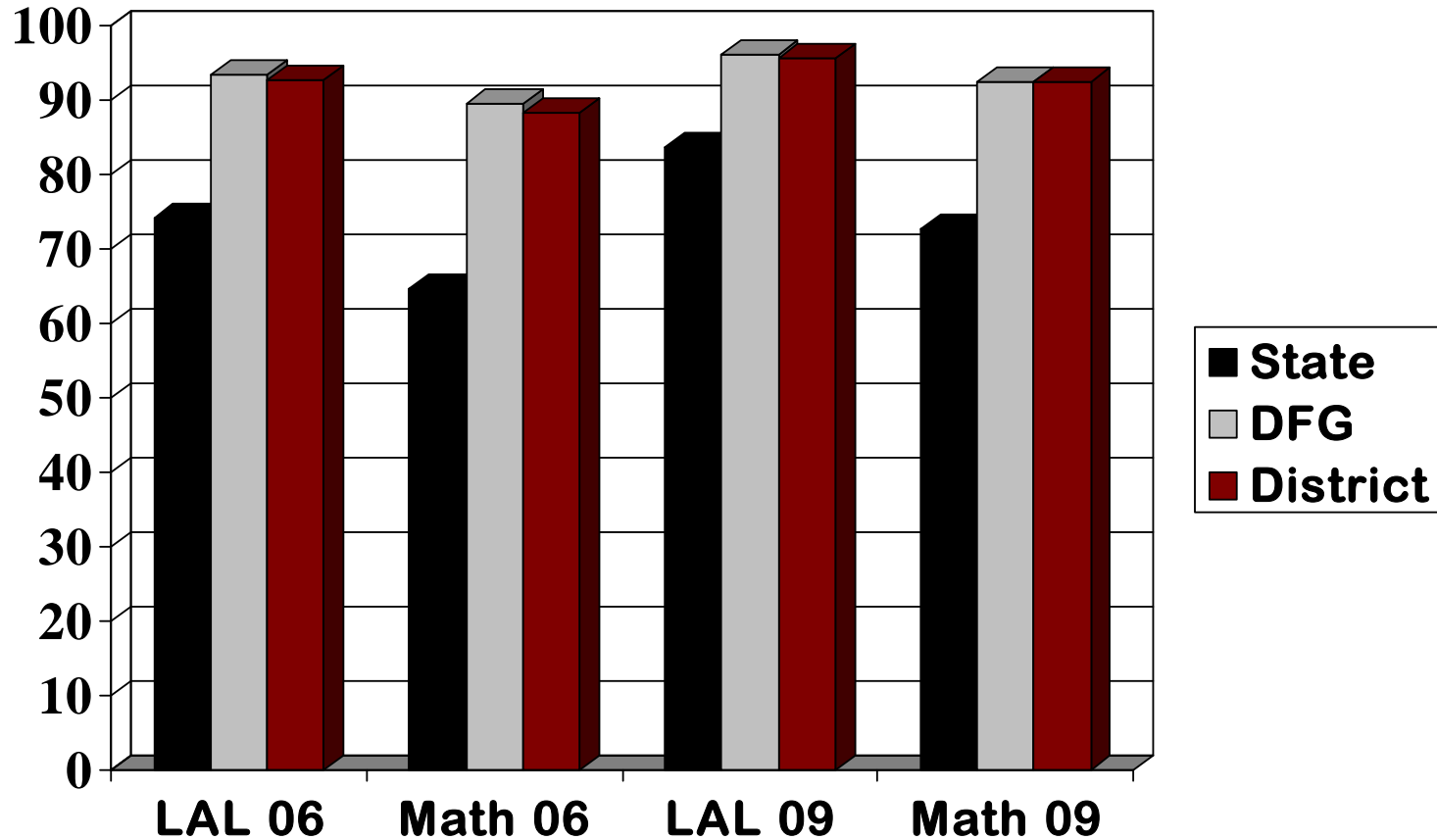

Total Students % Proficient/Advanced Proficient



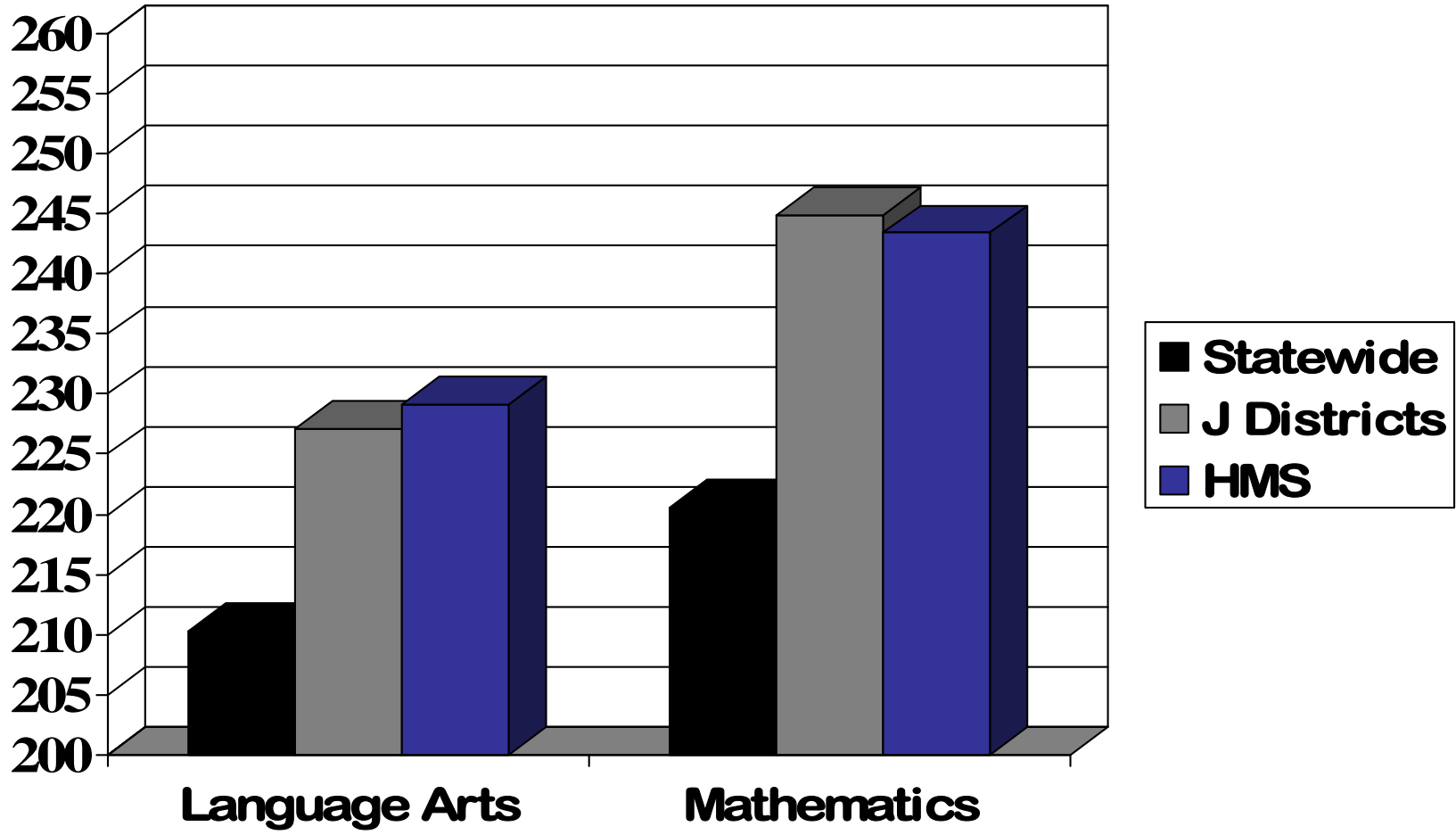
# NJ ASK 6-8 and HSPA Mean Score Performance



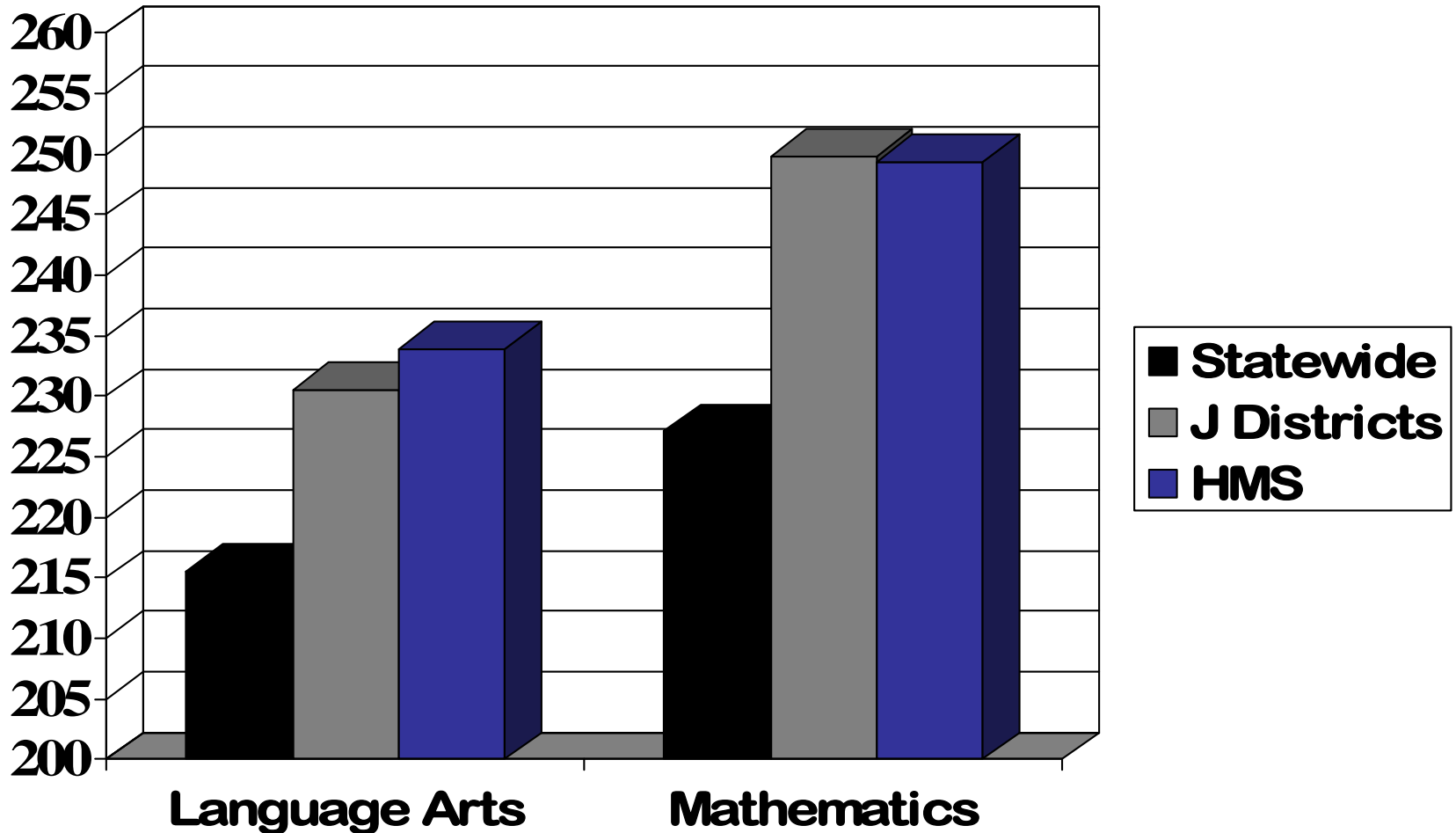

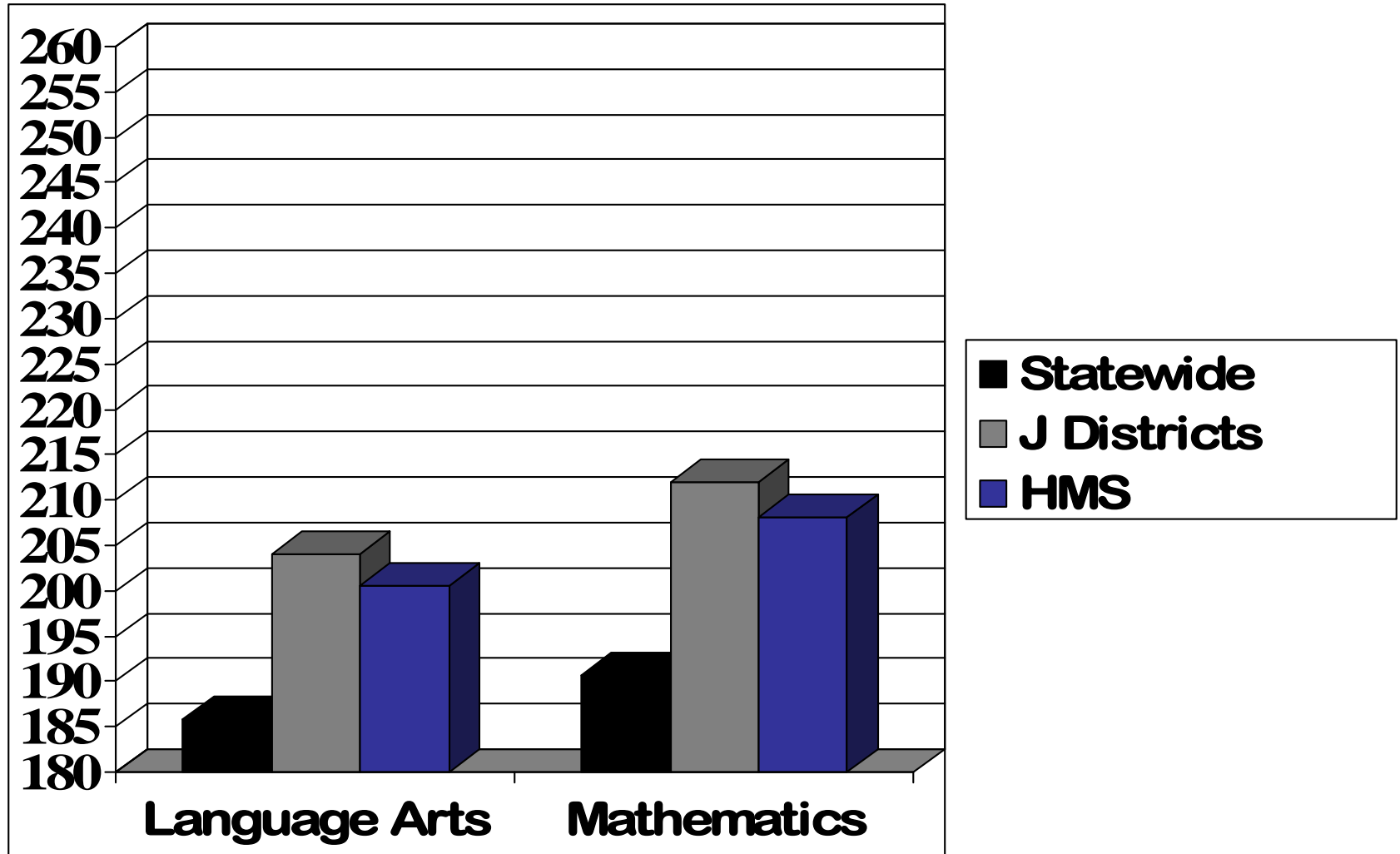

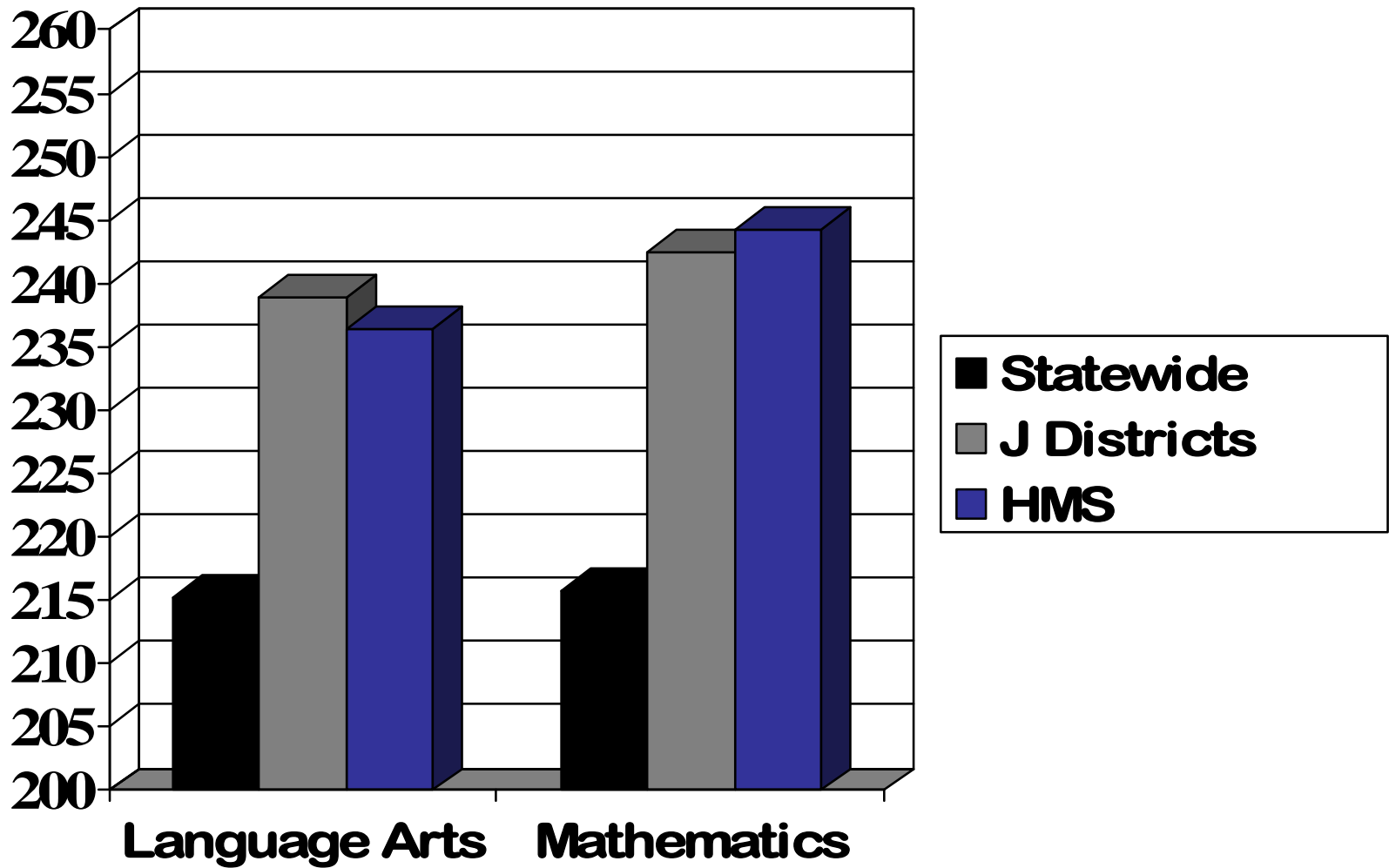
# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade NJ ASK 09 – General Ed.

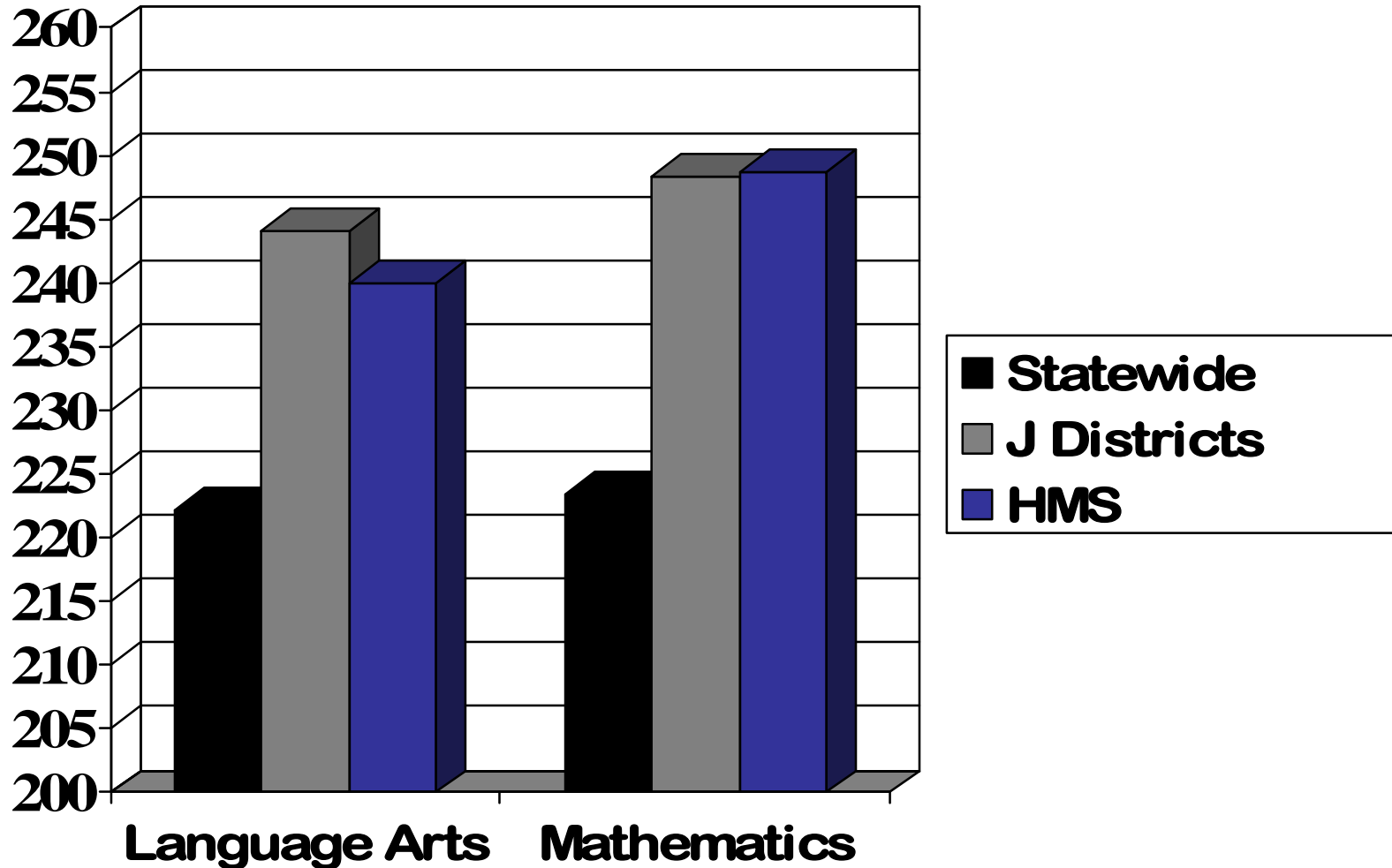

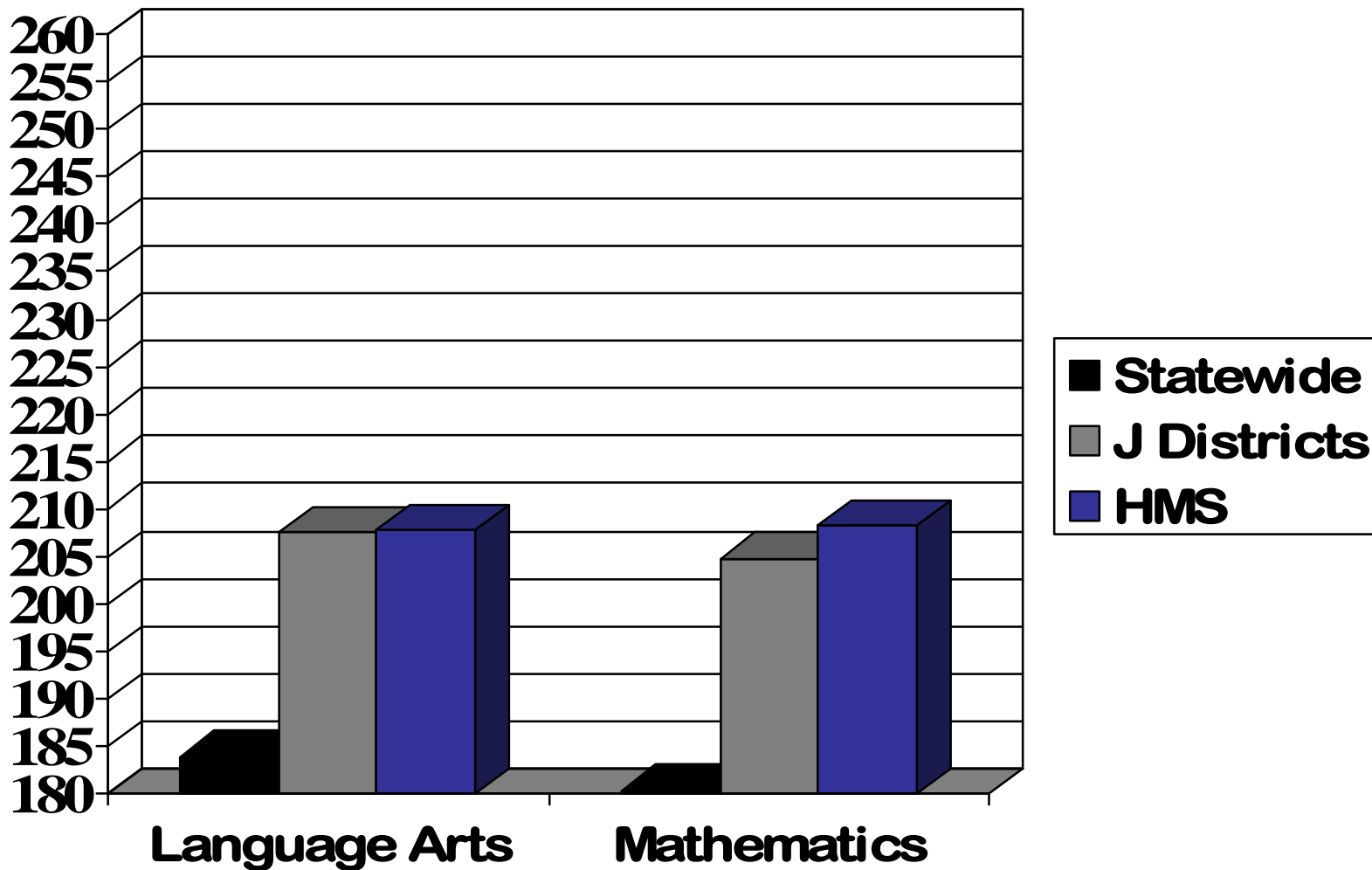

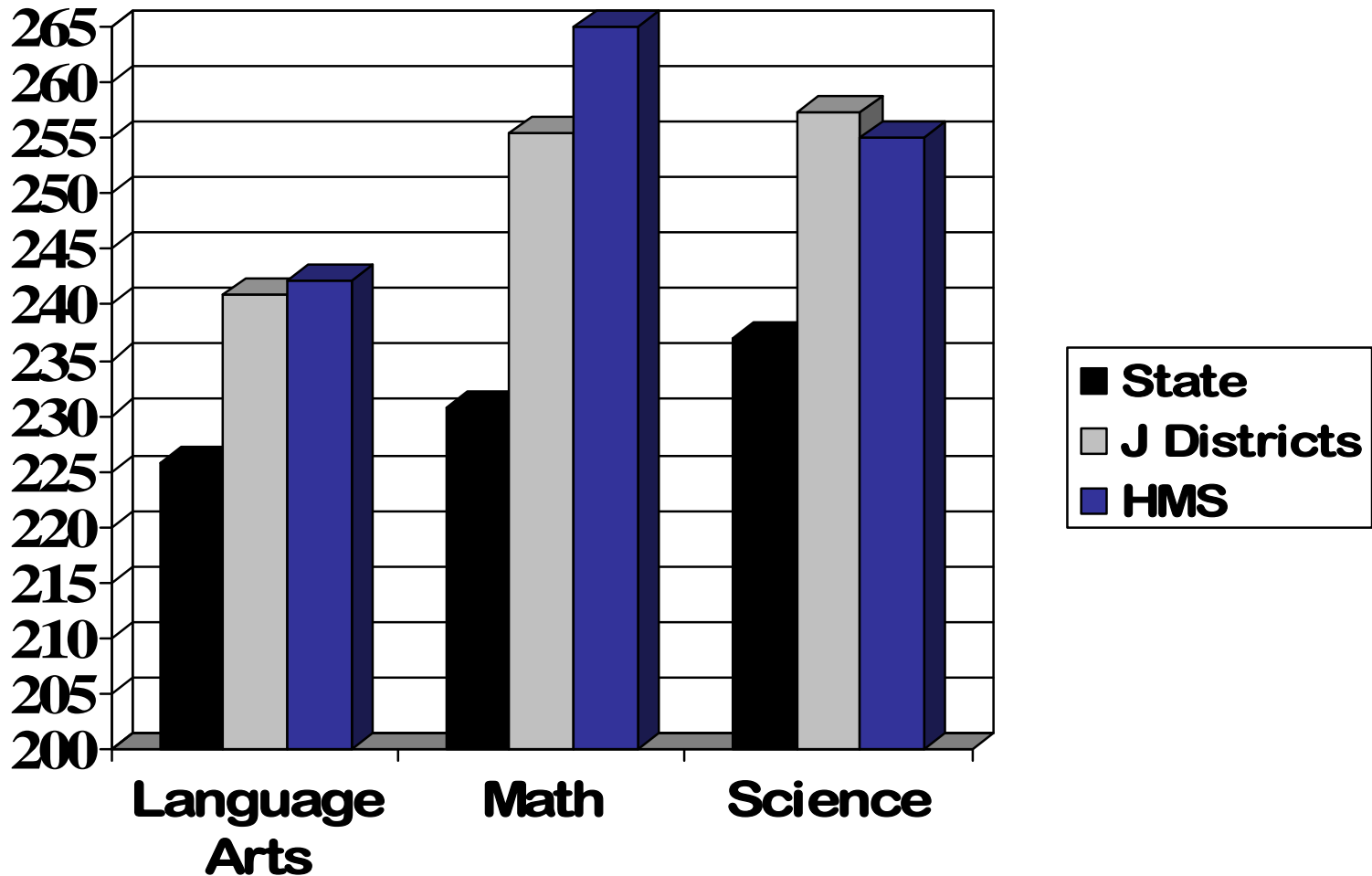

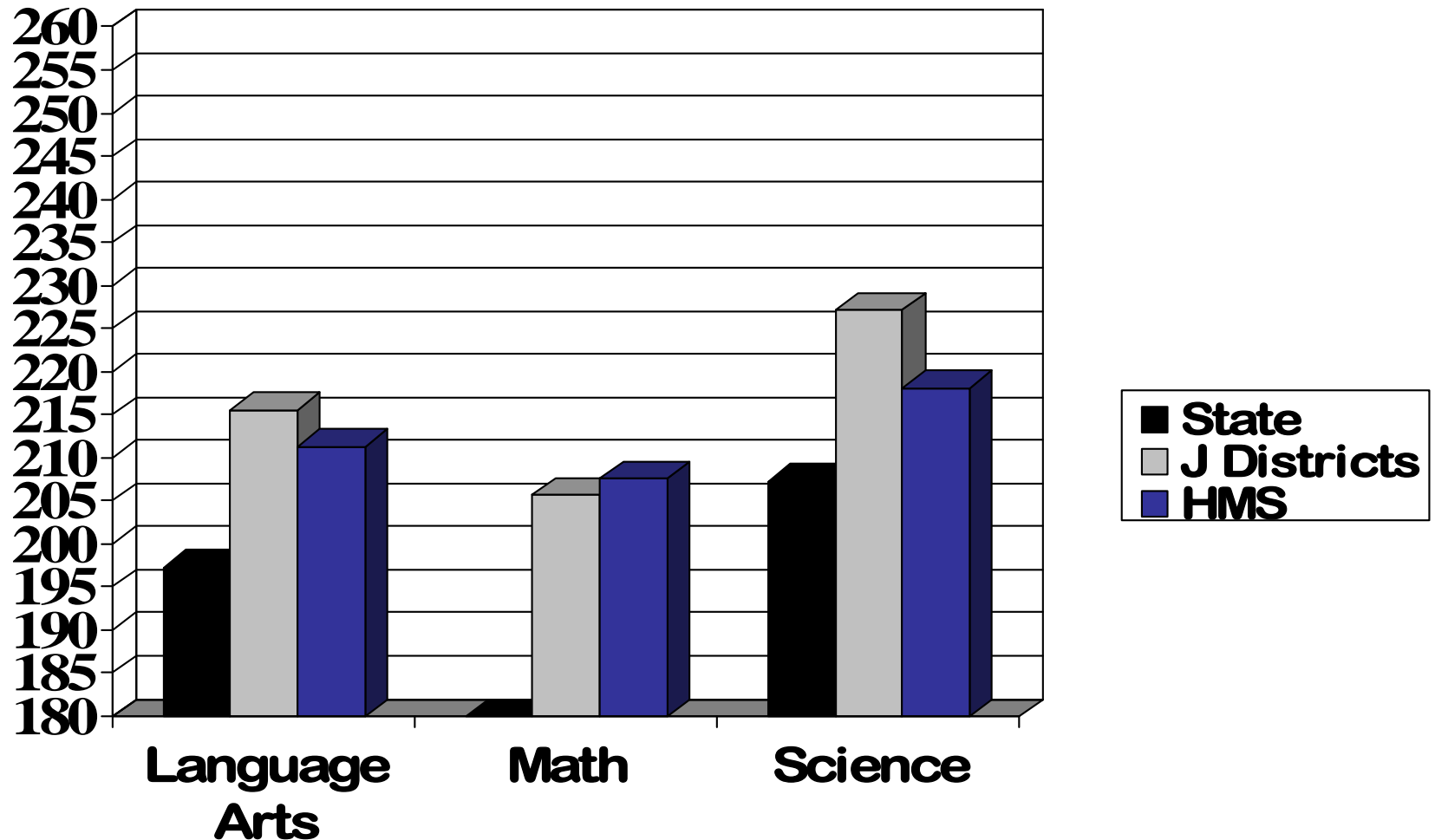

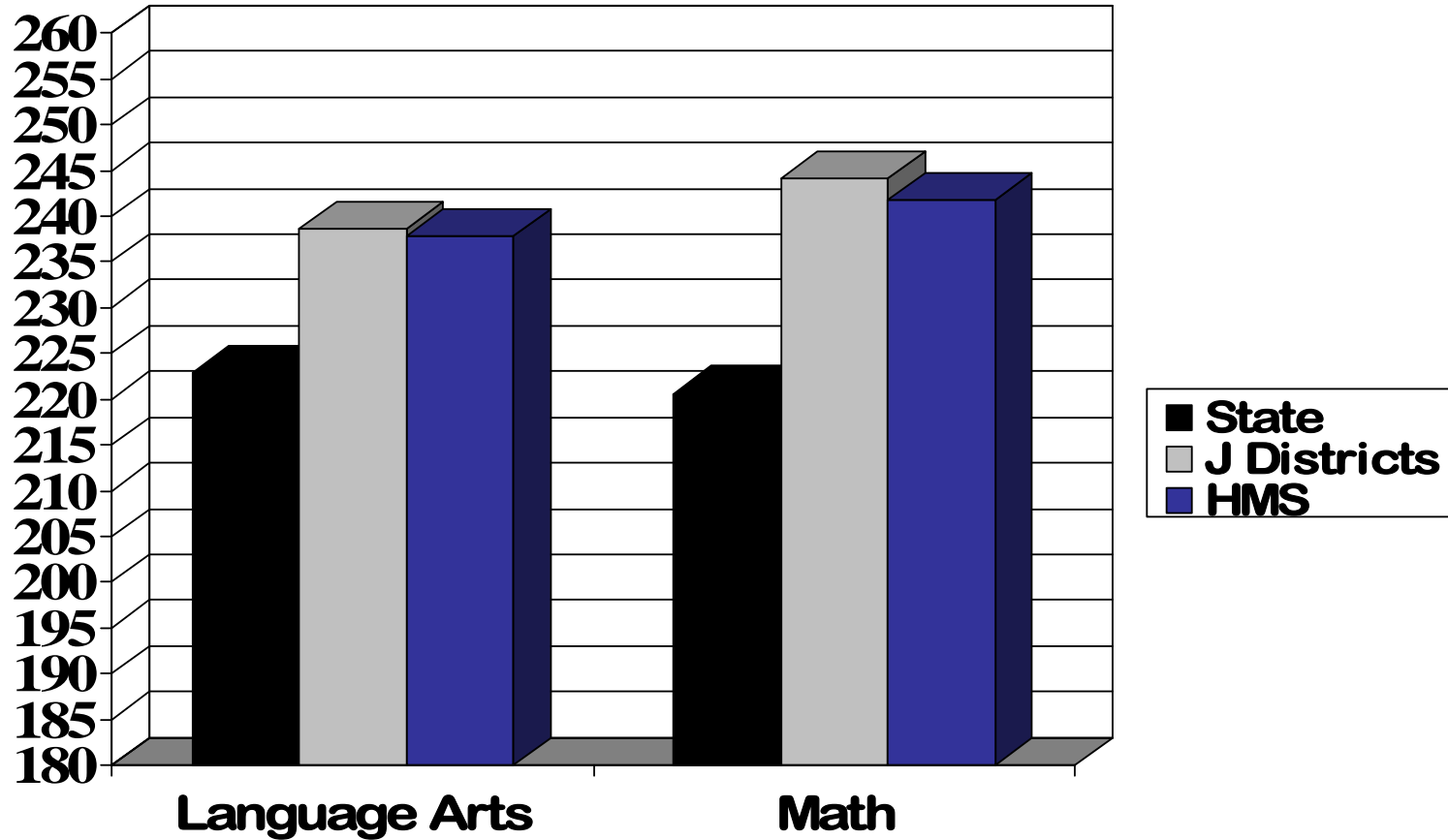

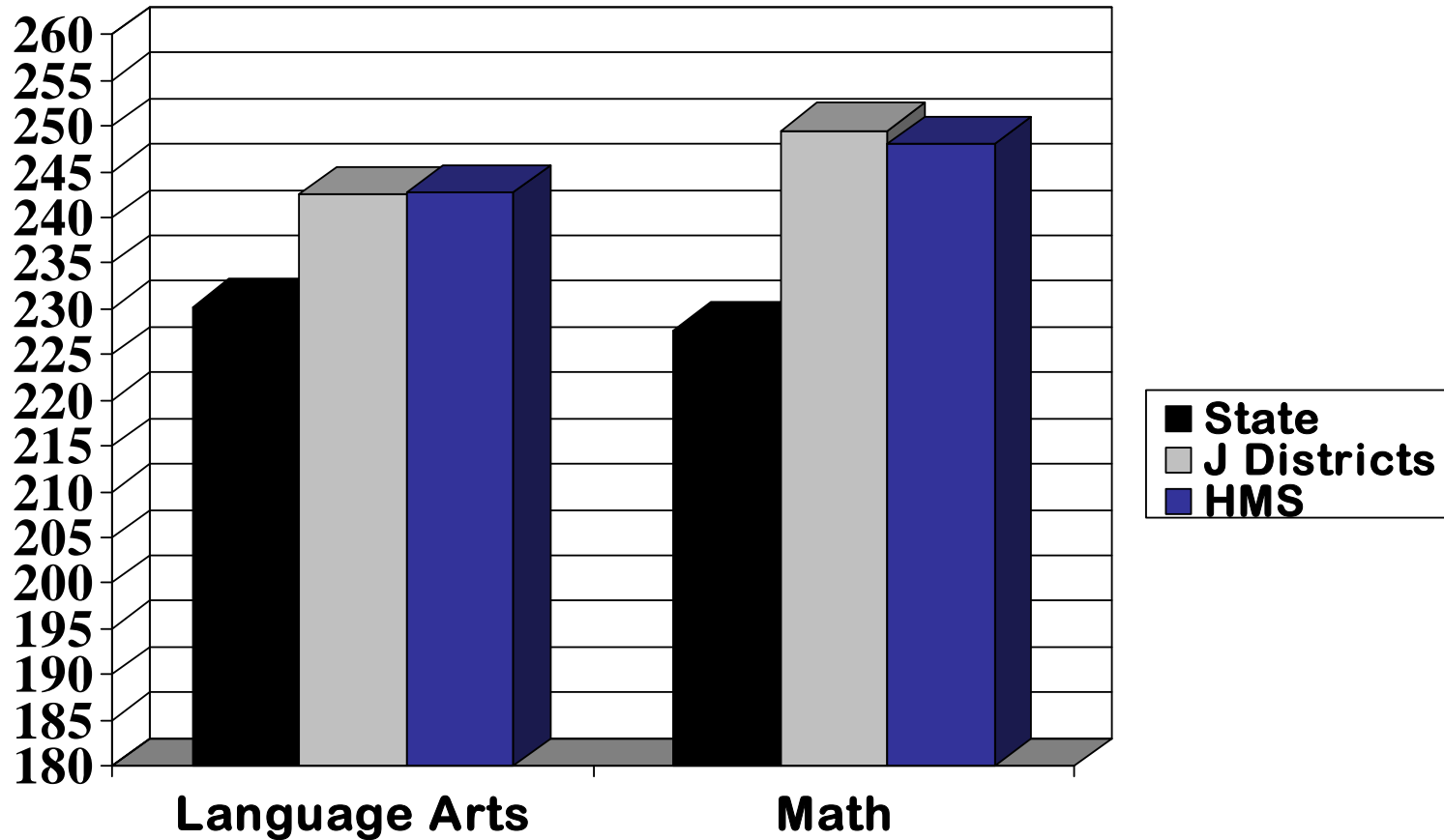

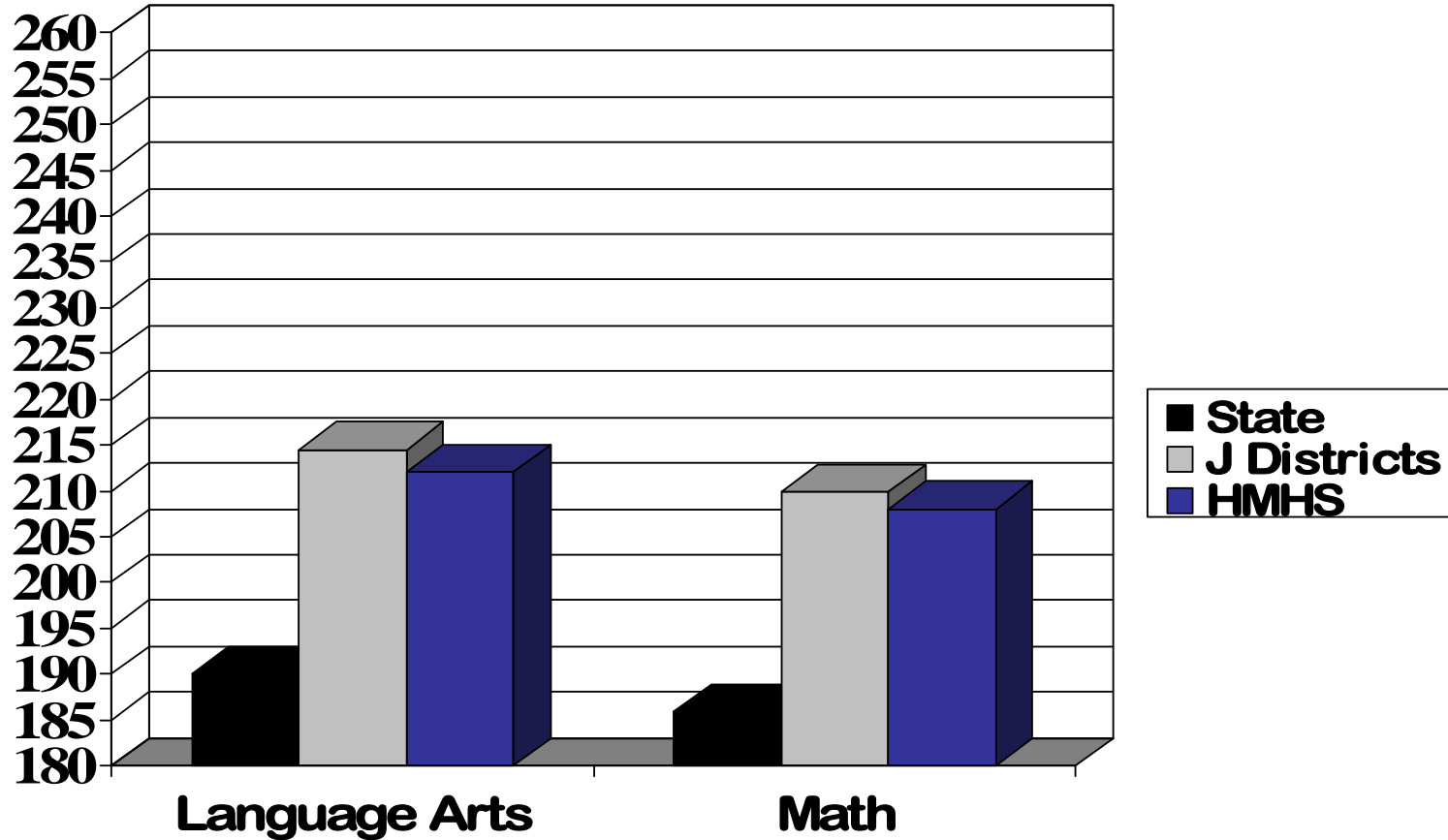

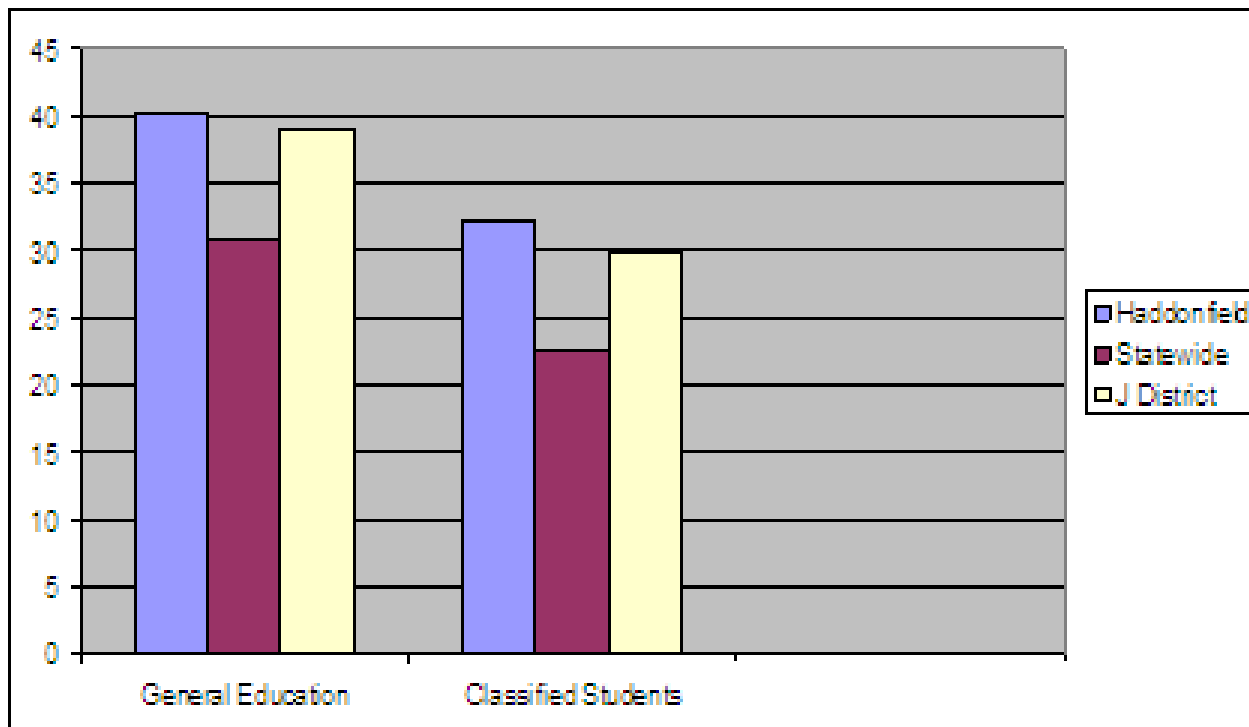

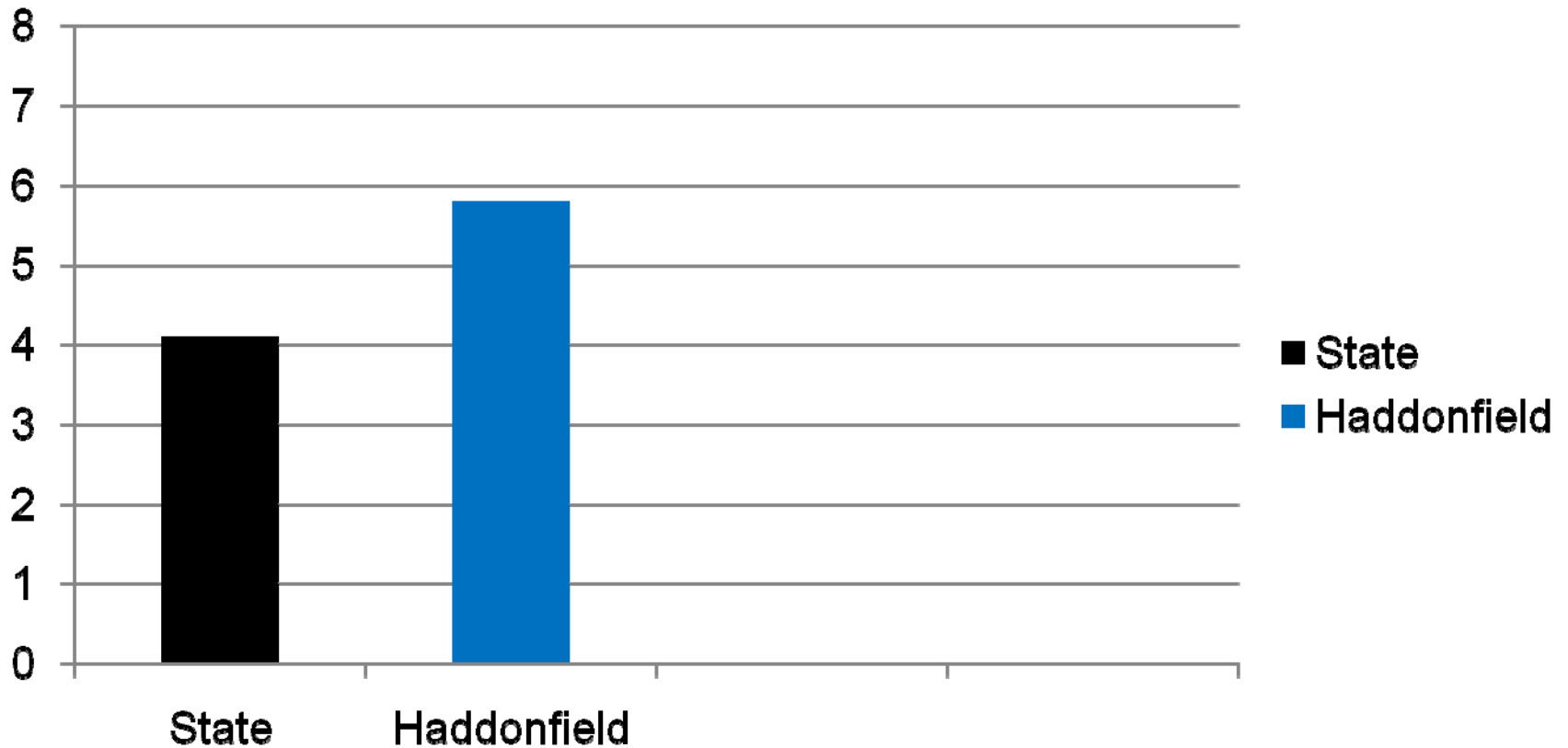
# HMHS EOC Biology Test 2009

## 8 Pt. Scoring Rubric

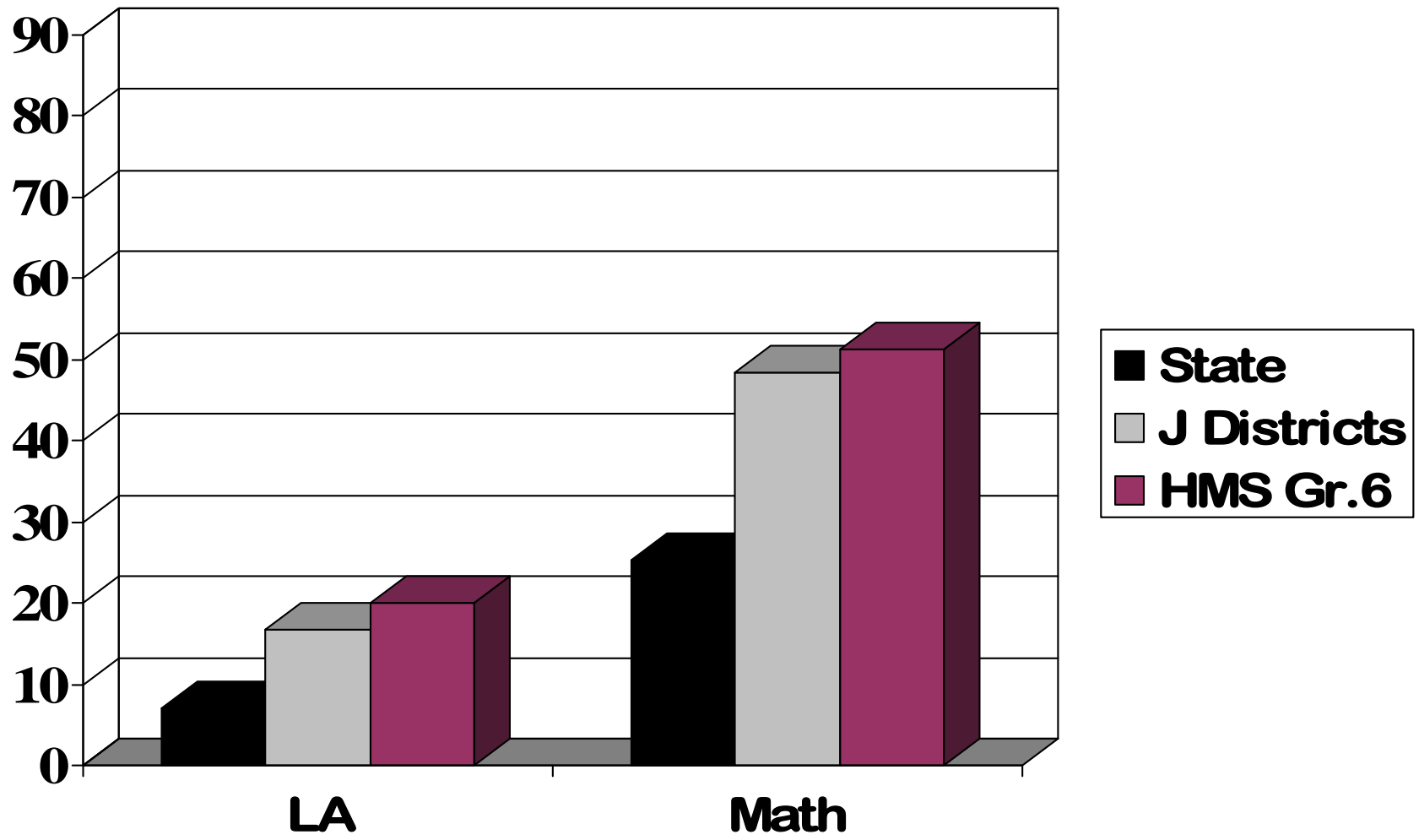

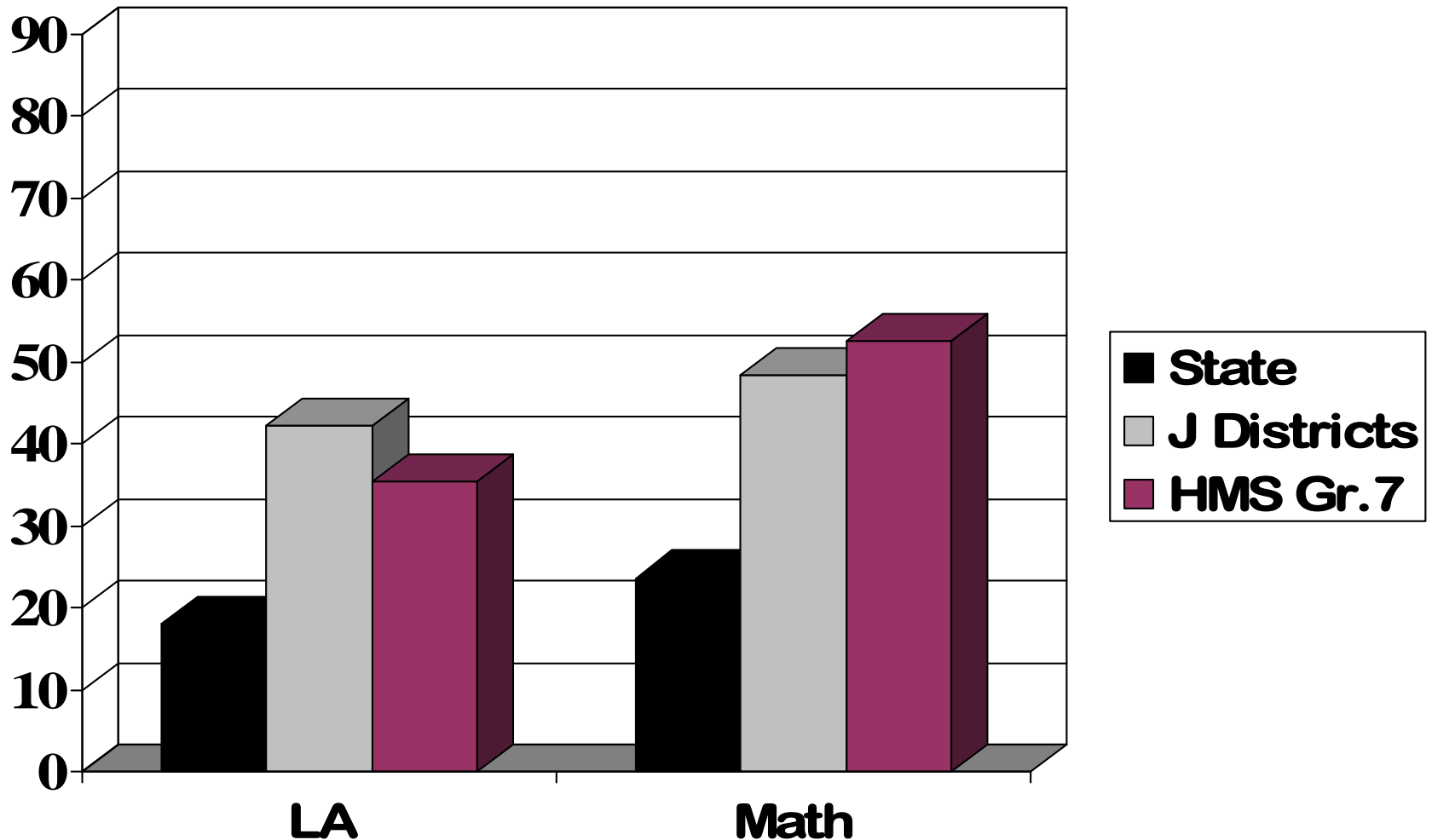

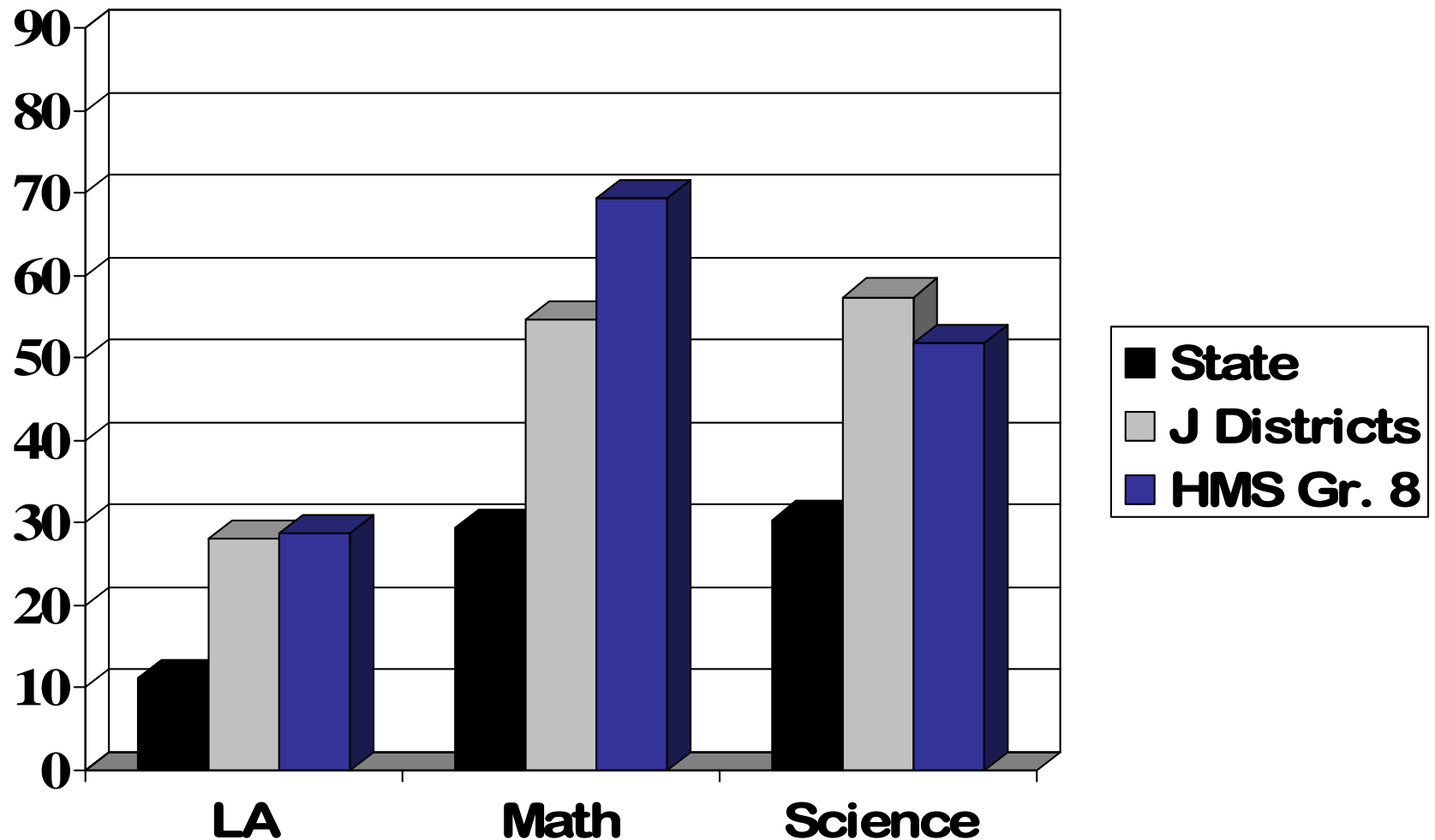
# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade NJ ASK 09 – Total Students Percent Advanced Proficient



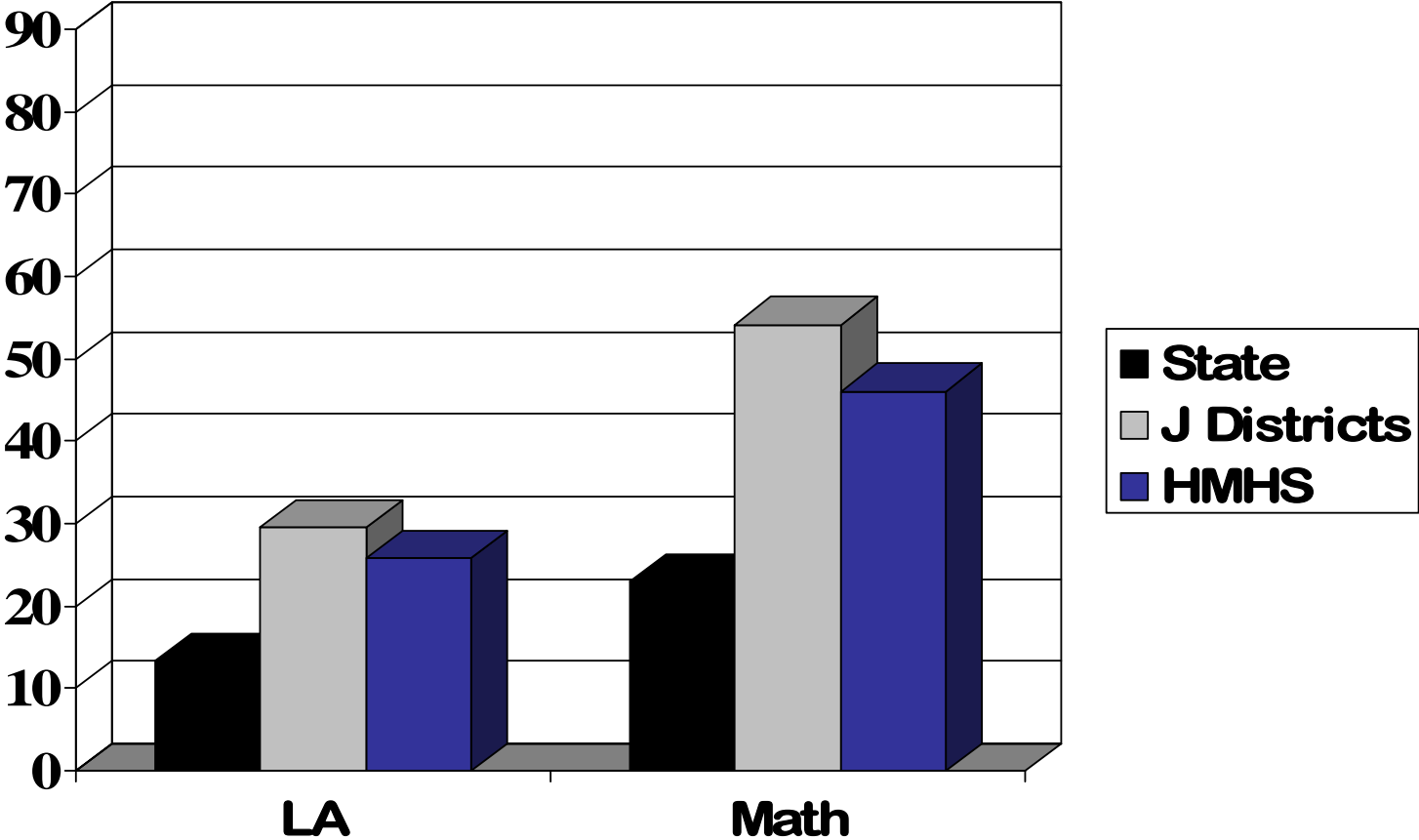
# 7<sup>th</sup> Grade NJ ASK 09 – Total Students Percent Advanced Proficient



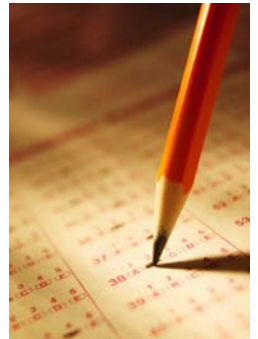
# 8<sup>th</sup> Grade NJ ASK 09 – Total Students Percent Advanced Proficient



# 11<sup>th</sup> Grade HSPA 09 – Total Students Percent Advanced Proficient



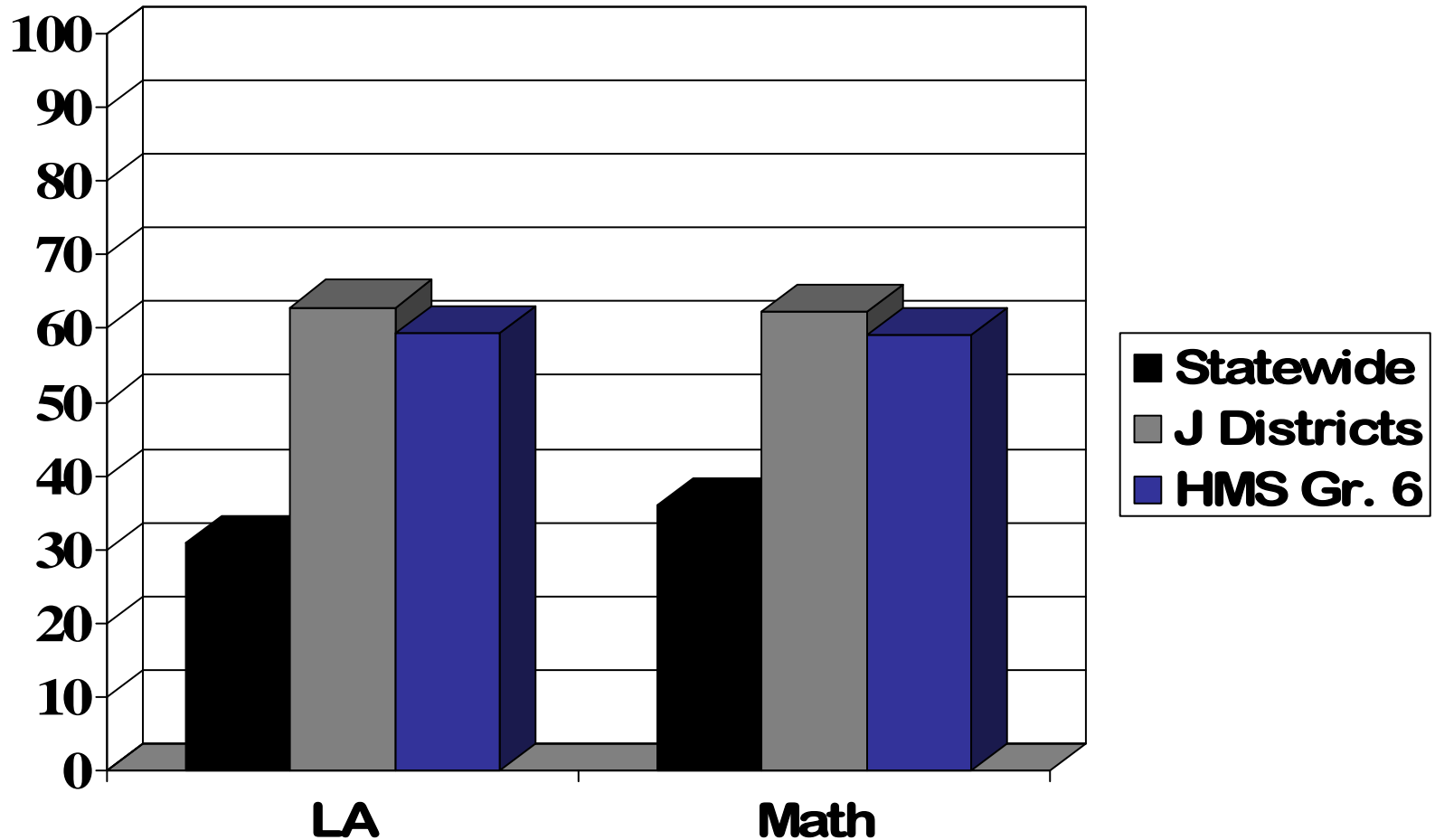

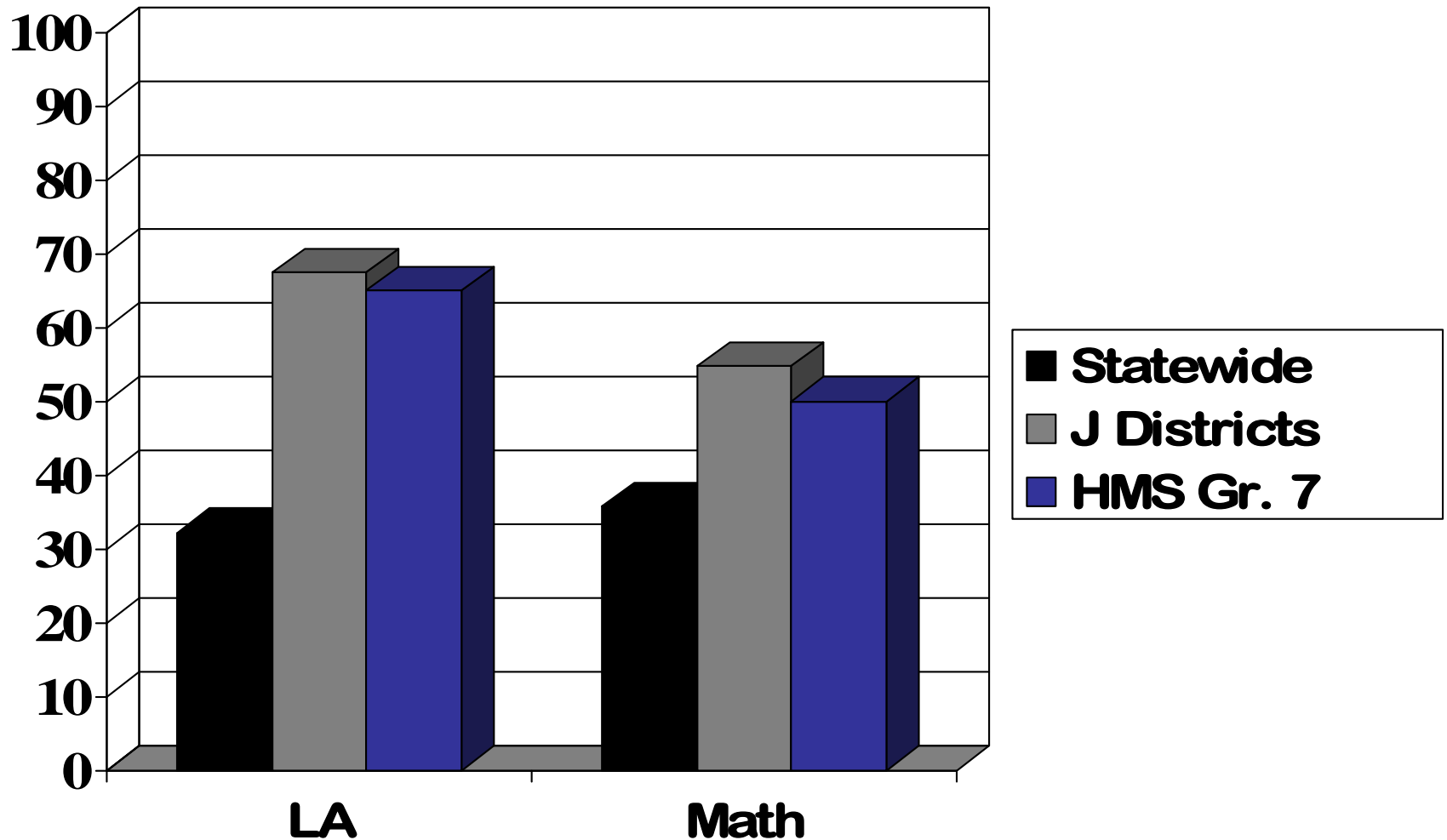
State, DFG, district and building results

Special Education students



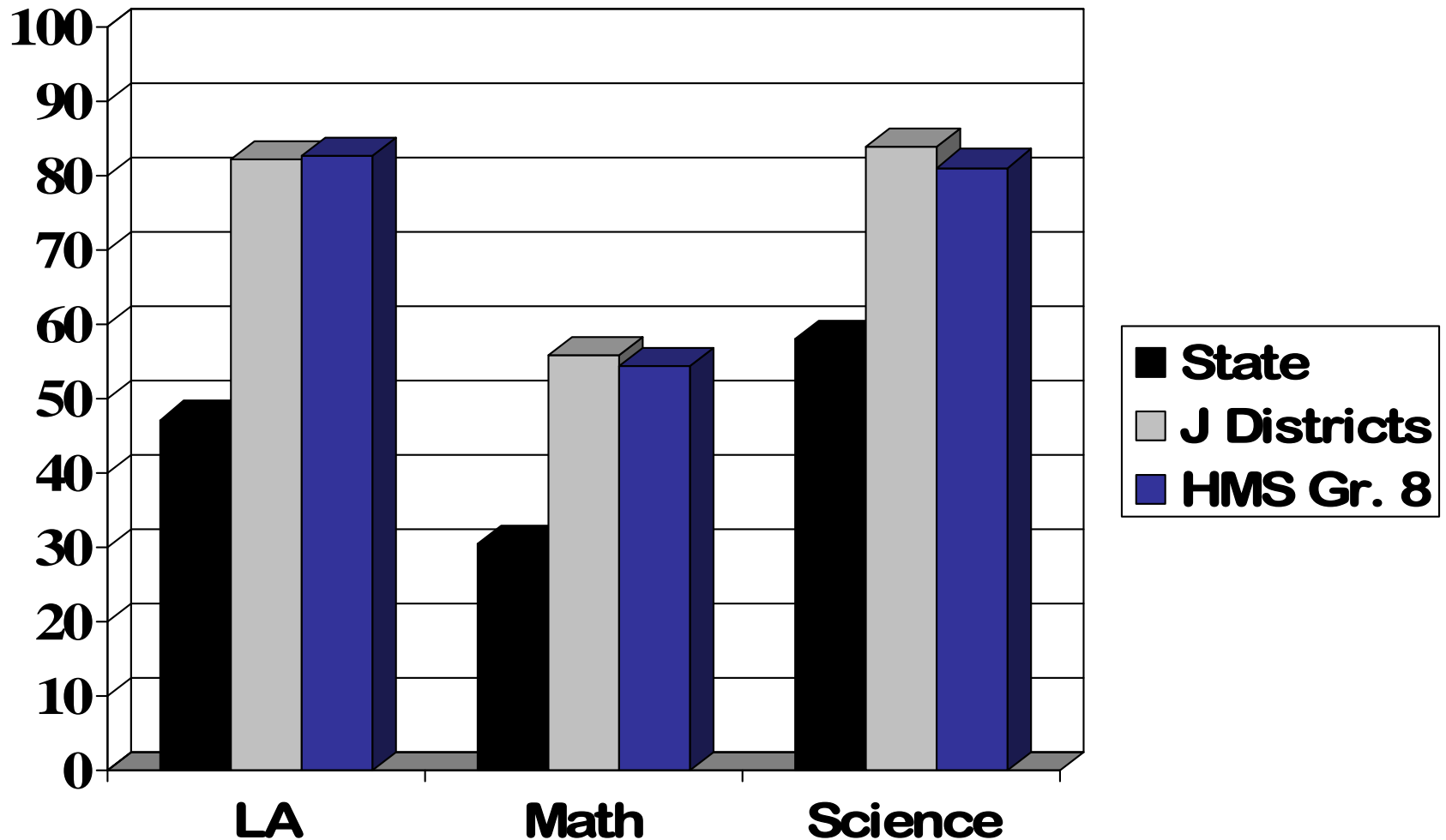
# 6<sup>th</sup> Grade – NJ ASK Percent Passing Special Education Students 2009
