<i>July-August</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Be sure you have registered with the NCAA Eligibility Center if you wish to participate in Division I or II intercollegiate athletics • Verify that your schedule accurately reflects what you chose - if necessary, complete and submit a Summer Course Request Change Form • Consider registering for the SAT or ACT • Begin your college applications and essays • Update Naviance resume
<i>September</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Accept invitation to New Student Breakfast – for students new to the district • Consider taking ACT • Attend Club Fair • Attend college representative meetings • Attend Senior Meeting to review college application process • Review transcript for accuracy • Check scholarship list in Naviance • Complete college applications and essays • Request transcripts by September 30 for October 15 deadline • Request letters of recommendation from teachers, if necessary
<i>October</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consider taking SAT or SAT Subject Tests or ACT • Retake HSPA sections, if necessary • Complete the CSS PROFILE, if necessary • Attend college representative meetings • Complete college applications and essays • Attend College Night • Check scholarship list in Naviance • Request transcripts by October 15 for November 1 deadline
<i>November</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request transcripts by November 1 for November 15 deadline • Request transcripts by November 15 for December 1 deadline

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consider taking SAT or SAT Subject Tests • Attend college representative meetings • Check scholarship list in Naviance • Complete college applications and essays
December	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request transcripts by December 1 for January 1 deadline • Receive Early Decision / Early Action decisions • Consider taking SAT or SAT Subject Tests or ACT • Complete college applications and essays • Attend Financial Aid presentation for students • Consider attending Financial Aid Meeting for parents • Check scholarship list in Naviance
January	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) • Complete college applications and essays • Consider On-Site Admissions Program • Check scholarship list in Naviance
February	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check scholarship list in Naviance
March	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete and submit local scholarship application • Retake HSPA sections, if necessary
April	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Evaluate and compare financial aid awards from colleges and decide on your final college choice • Indicate final college selection for local scholarships • Inform colleges if you will not be attending
May	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Notify college of choice by May 1 • Take AP exams, if appropriate • Update all college admission decisions in Naviance
June	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Register for summer school, if necessary • Indicate final college selection in Naviance
