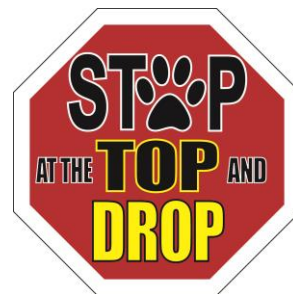


Tatem Morning Drop-off Reminders



- **8:15 am to 8:25 am** is the drop off time, (not before)
- Safety Parents will be on hand to assist your child out of the car
- **“Stop at the Top and Drop”** – pull forward to the large tree with the orange ribbon. Do not allow your children to exit the car before you pass the tree
The beginning and end of the Drop off Zone is marked with street signs
 - Be sure to pull all the way up as close to the far sign as possible
 - Children should exit their car from the passenger side only
- Parents should not leave their car or park their car at the curb – even temporarily
- Stay in the traffic line, cutting out of line puts our children at risk

Thank you for your cooperation, it allows the procedure to work smoothly and efficiently.

HELPFUL TIPS

Kindergarten and Preschool
 The Kindergarten/Preschool Assisted Drop Off System begins at 8:20am (Preschool from 8:37am-8:45am)
 Enter the drop-off lane near the entrance to the school via Evergreen Lane/Glover.
 Pull into the circular drive and wait for school personnel to escort your child(ren).
 Please never allow your child(ren) to exit the vehicle on their own.

Grades 1-5
 Enter the drop-off lane near the entrance to the school via Evergreen Lane/Glover.
 Cars should enter the drop-off lane but not allow students to exit car until they reach the big tree with the **ORANGE** ribbon.
 The drop-off lane works much more safely and efficiently when cars pull up until there is no more room, allowing as many cars as possible to access the drop-off lane.
 Cars are encouraged to make a right turn onto Grove Street. At that time of the day, it is difficult to make a left, which backs up cars accessing Grove.
